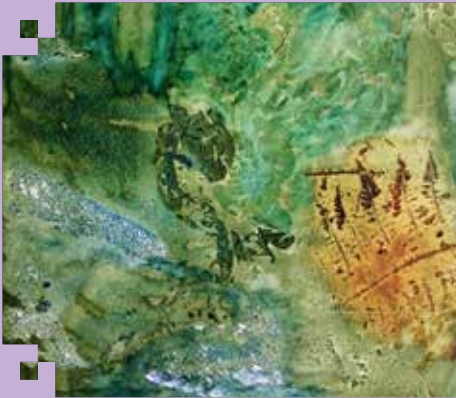
8th - 27th February
